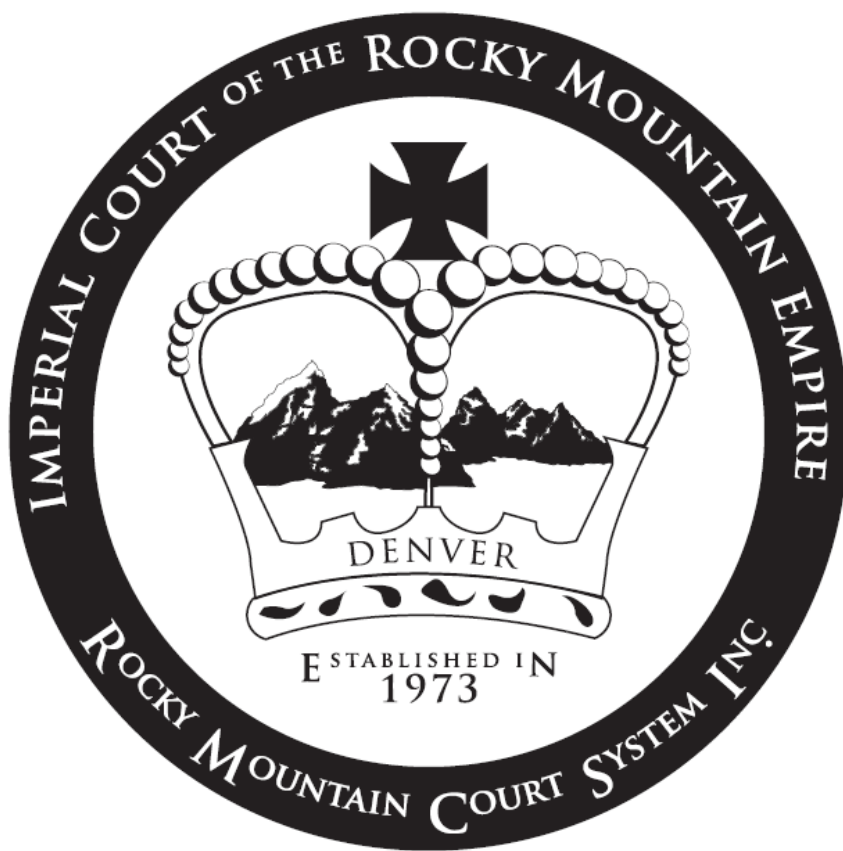
The Court continued to grow and better represent Colorado under the able leadership of the Emperor and Empress II. During the second reign there was still room for many firsts. Emperor and Empress II were indeed the true powers of the thrones during this reign. Scotti was the first candidate to use buttons and t-shirts during her campaign. Bucky was the first Monarch to hold a function to raise money for the newly established Gay & Lesbian Community Center of Colorado. They were the first to take a political stance and aided the Gay Community in stopping excessive police harassment over jaywalking tickets to patrons of The Broadway.

These monarchs are also the first elected monarchs in the Empire, with fifty per cent of the election being composed of a judges panel and the remaining fifty per cent coming from an election by popular vote of the Coronation attendees. Denver was also welcomed into the International Court System and truly recognized as a new court with the attendance of Jose I of San Francisco at Scotti's and Bucky's stepping down.

The line of succession also became an integral part of the Court. Billie Cassandra, first runner-up for Empress, became Princess Royale; with Lola as Queen Mother; Christi Layne as Grand Duchess; Desiree as Czarina and Causha Lee Victoria as Marquessa (a title created and added to the line of succession along with Marquis by Bucky). Bucky also saw the wisdom of male line of succession. Debbie Youngman, first runner-up for Emperor, became Prince Royale being replaced by Gary Korf at his stepping down and then Kenny McDonald at Causha and Shel's stepping down. Pat was Grand Duke, with Louis (Louise) as Czar, and Rose as Marquis.

Scotti and Bucky awarded a permanent title to someone they felt had been special during their reign, and also deserved special merit from the city and so Ms. Vivian Soloman was awarded the permanent title, Guardian Angel of the Court for Life.

Three other functions took hold and began to be part of the ICRME calendar. The first was the PR Ball with the theme of the Hookers and Hustlers Ball held above the now demolished Court Jester. Then followed the Empress's Snowball with its theme: Toys for Tots. Finally was the Emperor's King of Hearts Ball with the theme, An Old Fashioned Square Dance held at another legendary dance palace, The 1942. The end of Reign Two came with their stepping down theme of Colorado: 1776-2076 celebrating the bicentennial and opening the gates for the Third Reign.

Strength in leadership and someone who truly loved our Court System are only two of the adjectives which described Emperor and Empress XII, Jamie Cole and Dave (Boom Boom) Lorette. The Twelfth Emperor and Empress were both extremely organized individuals and this reign proved to be one of the better administratively run. It emphasized the importance of including the entire reign by organizing caravans of court members to visit other cities in the realm. Boom Booms outstanding wit and sense of humor, coupled with Jamies vast store of court history, made them both very popular at out of town Coronations, and wonderful representatives for the city at many fundraisers and organizational events they attended. A very busy year for the court was highlighted by the completion of the project to restore stained glass windows at Metropolitan Community Church, with the court purchasing one window in its name.

The PR Ball was held at Rossis with the theme An Evening in Monte Carlo, And, as had become tradition, allowed Jamie and Boom Boom the opportunity to introduce their lines of succession and a host of other court titles. Snow Ball, Christmas on the Strip", was held at the Radisson and of course featured the headdress competition. The Radisson also played host for A Night on Skid Row, the Twelfth Reigns King of Hearts Ball. Planning Coronation for this year was an interesting event all by itself. Due to an error in double booking, the ICRME and the Radisson had to go into negotiations and as a result, the ICRME received most of the hotels services and facilities for free.

Both monarchs had wonderfully supportive lines of succession. Empress XII, Jamie was aided in her efforts by Princess Royale, Mona Del Ray; Queen Mother, Pearl DeVere; Grand Duchess, Ashley Novak; Czarina, Roxie LaMont; Marquessa, Valerie; and Reina, Billie Yates. In turn, Emperor XII, Boom Boom was helped by his Prince Royale, Fred Valdez; King Father, Ron Heath; Grand Duke, Gail Whittington and Czar, Chuck Bates. The Empress chose to award her permanent title for this year to Ashley Novak: Countess of Love to Empress XII for Life. Boom Boom awarded his permanent title to Vince Kline as Sir Vince, Knight of the Realm for Life.

Amid a Vegas-inspired setting, the Twelfth Reign presented Coronation XIII, Hallelujah Vegas! A Night of Imperial Entertainment, at the Downtown Radisson Hotel. It was in this spectacular setting that Reign 13 took up the reins of power and began their Imperial Journey.

For the first time in court history, a regent Emperor was asked to fulfill the position left vacant by an elected Monarch. King Father, Thom Frey, joined Empress Alyssa to complete an otherwise storybook reign with her. Thom was granted fill status as Emperor at King of Hearts in 1998. During their year we saw the only Touch of Class in recent years to host all of the ICRME Empresses in town. Awards were won by the 22nd reign including best float during Pridefest parade and several best entrance awards for out of state Coronations. The most notable contribution of the 22nd Reign was the first annual Thanksgiving Food Drive for CAP. CAP was the recipient of over 800 Thanksgiving baskets to their clients. The reign was marked by numerous contributions to charity and the tireless efforts of the largest dues paid members Court in the history of the Court made this a most successful year.

PR Ball was themed Stars of the Silver Screen held at the Regency. Snow Ball was Ice Castles and was a resounding success for Angels Unaware. The annual King of Hearts was titled A 1930s Archeological Adventure Montezumas Revenge and it was during this function that Thom appointed a new King Father who is still serving this organization today in that capacity, John Schlegel.

Strong lines of succession and the largest lines helped make this year what it was. Some of the line members were, Prince Royale, Kristin Phillips; Prince Royale, Robert Flores; Grand Duke and Duchess, Raymond Sackett and Chyna Blue; Czar and Czarina, Jeff Clark and Portia Houston; Marquis and Marquessa, Wendy Saxton and Coco Chanel and Don and Reina, Lee Doudney and Morgan. Thom gave his permanent title to JJ Cochran as Legendary Prince of Wisdom.

This history making year ended at The Regency Grand Ballroom with Aztec- The Legend Beyond in grand style and marked the first time that a ten year and a twenty year Anniversary of the Monarchy was celebrated and opened the door for the 23rd year of the ICRME.

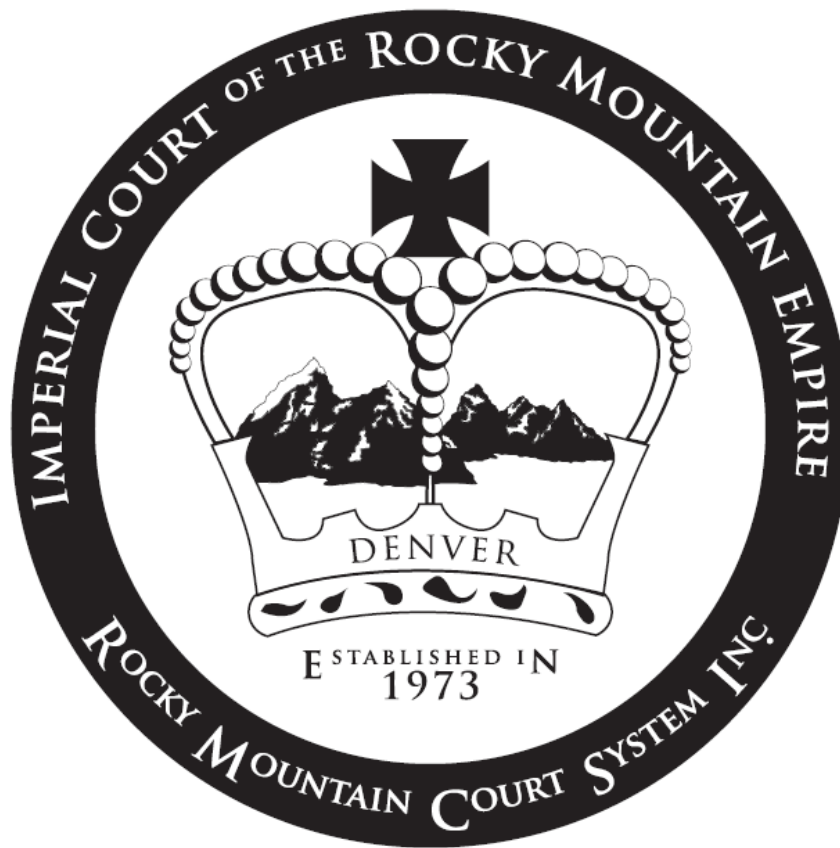

The strong presence of the 32nd Imperial family was very evident throughout the year. The Imperial Family consisted of the Hard working duet Mr. Jeff Hoppe, Prince Royale XXXII and Ms. Barbie Blake, Princess Royale XXXII. Also within the foundation of the family was Supreme Queen Mother Scotti Carlyle. Helping to support the Monarchs was the King Father 32 Brad Busby and Queen Mother Greta B. Quick. Godfather Gregg Looker and God Mother Ida Maybe. There to always support was Grand Duke 32 Allen Hasket and Grand Duchess Mercedes Blake. Jon "Crunchy" Crenshaw and Katrina St. Andrews were the Czar and Czarina. The Marquis Ms Eryn alongside her Marquessa Karen Phillips. DC reigned as Don 32 with Reina Chardonay Thomas. Baron and Baroness were Baker Wolf and Brie Alexander. Count 32 Chandler Rayle and Countess 32 Mona Little followed by Viscount Curtis Angel Blake with Viscountess Kiley Monroe. Crown prince 32 was Josh Zellmer with his Crown Princess Mackenzie Morgan. and to round out the team for the year was Imperial Lord Mark Negelman and Imperial Lady Khobie monroe.

April 15, 2005 began the great journey for Emperor XXXII Lamar Cooper and Empress XXXII Scarlet fever which they led right into Gay pride where they received an award for best float. The monarchs were honored to represent the I.C.R.M.E. along the side of Ms. Colorado at Pink Ribbons largest Fundraiser.

Building relationships was the goal for the 32nd elected monarchs and they did just that by re-establishing the tight family bond with daughter court from Colorado Springs (UCPPE). Also establishing strong relationship with many bars within the community such as The Denver Triangle where many of the 32nd reign events were held. They stepped out of the fundraising box again by holding a progressive dinner "An evening at the Piazza". As their year began its descent we were able to partner with a new hotel, the Sheraton Four Points where Empress XXXII Scarlet Fever Hosted the 32nd Annual Snow Ball "Babes In Toyland" in November 2006 which was a big hit in the city and with profits. Also making a Big splash in the city for functions at the Sheraton Four Points Hotel was Emperor XXXII Lamar Coopers'

King of Hearts "An Imperial Evening With The Phantom" which was hosted in March 2007. April 15, 2006 would be an evening NO ONE would ever forget as it went off with a BANG at Holiday INN DIA. "Legends of The Silver Screen, A Evening on the Red Carpet" was hosted by the 32nd elected monarchs with many visiting dignitaries here to support.

As I sit here with the Massive Empress Gabbriella But'zin, we reminisce about our time as the reigning Monarchs of Denver.

We reigned together as Prince and Princess 40. Running for the office of Emperor and Empress was our next step to continue our fundraising journey.

We ran unopposed and were elected Emperor and Empress 42 of the Mountain Court System on April 4, 2015. The next morning at Victory Brunch, Charles Rozanski and LaShay DiMarco were appointed Prince and Princess Royale 42.

Wasting no time naming our lines of succession, Investitures was held 2 weeks later at Club M. Our lines of succession were as follows:

Within the first 60 days, our reign raised over \$10,000 for charity. The family came together to help at Free Comic Book day to raise money for White Rose Scholarship and were fortunate enough to entertain none other than the Incredible Hulk himself, Lou Ferrigno, the night before Gabbie went Gamorra for the Cos-Play Pre-ComicCon party which also benefited White Rose.

During that time, we also attended Salt Lake City's coronation. We were honored to travel with the first 40th year anniversary Empress 2, Scotti Carlye, and King Father to reign 42 Emperor 7, Gary Edwards. We attended along with members of our line Prince Royale 42 Charles Rozanski, Princess Royale 42 LaShay DiMarco, Grand Duke R.C. Michaels, Don Daniel Cocker, Brother to Emperor 42, Ron Atkinson, as well as Emperor 19 John Menchaca, Empress 39 Martini Monroe, Empress 41 Melissa Nawrocki, Prince Royale 41 Jim Babb, College of Cardinals Norrie Reynolds and MJ Rebelez.

On to Albuquerque's Coronation. In contingency with us were family members Juana Man, Manny Sexton, Obi Sparkles, Ladycat De'Ore, and R.C. Michaels, along with College of Cardinal members Norrie Reynolds & Rodd with 2 D's, I.C.R.M.E. members Jackie O and Tammy Brunette, and Monarchs Empress 2 Scotti Carlyle, Emperor 7 Gary Edwards, Emperor 13 Chuck Bates, Empress 17 Brittany Michaels, Emperor 18 Gregg Looker, Empress 24 Nina Montaldo and Empress 35 Jackie Summers. We returned to Denver to begin building our float for Pride. Our theme for the year was all about Steampunk, and our float certainly portrayed this with actual moving gears, incredible costumes and flawless decorations! At the conclusion of the parade, the family all went directly to the bar booth to begin our shift! Reign 41 was gracious enough to have had opened the booth that morning so we were able to enjoy the parade upon our float.

July was an extraordinary month of events beginning with PR Picnic, Cherry Creek Arts Festival, which was I.C.R.M.E.'s first year to have an oversized corner booth with slushies, booze and more! Next came Rodeo, we staffed not only the beer trailer but also a large booze booth, and like always it rained and we were running around in more than an inch of water! Gabbie was lucky enough to have missed out while she was in Omaha attending their coronation with Emperor 39 Ken Bazan, along with College of Cardinal members Cory Wells and MJ Rebelez.

July came to an end only to discover that a horrendous embezzlement had taken place for over 2 years amounting in over sixty thousand dollars lost. Both Gabbie and myself were completely destroyed. The cash that had been raised since the beginning of our reign was gone, our beneficiaries had not been paid, and we were now 25% into our reign. Gabbie sat down with Outfront, letting the community know what had happened, and how we needed their support then more than ever! The determination of Reign 42, along with the community, resulted in Reign 42 re-raising and making whole all of I.C.R.M.E.'s commitments. Reign 42 continued to fundraise for it's chosen charities as well.

In September, Gabbie attended Des Moines coronation doing double duty not only as Empress 42, but also as the original recipient of the permanent title she received for the Denver Cycle Sluts during her time as their Queen Mother. Princess Royale 42, LaShay DiMarco, was also in attendance.

In October, our presence was requested by the Queen Mother and the ICS in Portland. Several individuals from the College of Monarchs were in attendance to show their support for Reign 42. That included Empress 2 Scotti Carlyle, Emperor 5 Bill Olson, Emperor 7 Gary Edwards, Emperor 13 Chuck Bates, Emperor 19 John Menchaca, Empress 17\ Brittany Michaels, Empress 24 Nina Montaldo, Empress 29 Jazmine James, and Emperor 29 Robert Flores. Heir Apparent Empress 35 Jackie Summers was there as well. We were there to provide the entire ICS information on the embezzlement, how it happened, what financial safeguards were being taken to insure it could never happen again. We also attended Portland's Coronation, which was held at the Art Museum. We had to get an Uber or Taxi to take us to the event. Well, my massive Empress was not happy when the Prius turned the corner. With much fan fair we shoved her into the tiny car and headed to Coronation. Upon arrival at the event Gabbie made the drive pull around the block so she could unpack from the car!

November came along to bring the Emperor & Empress ball which had become the combination the Empress's SnowBall and Emperor's King of Hearts, named "A Mechanical Wonderland". We were fortunate enough to hold the ball at Exdo Events Center, our beneficiaries were Urban Peak and Freedom Service Dogs. The following weekend, Denver arrived in force to our daughter court in Colorado Springs where Gabbie was honored with a permanent title of "Benevolent and Inspiring Empress to UCPPE for life"

In December, my Empress attended Las Vegas' coronation along with Princess Royale 42. That year Vegas had 9 members of the College of Monarchs that shared responsibilities for the past years reign. For the 1st time in several years, I.C.R.M.E. gave out crystal candy dishes instead of our trademark platters. Gabbie, as always, was in theme to coronation and received the "Best in Theme Female" award!

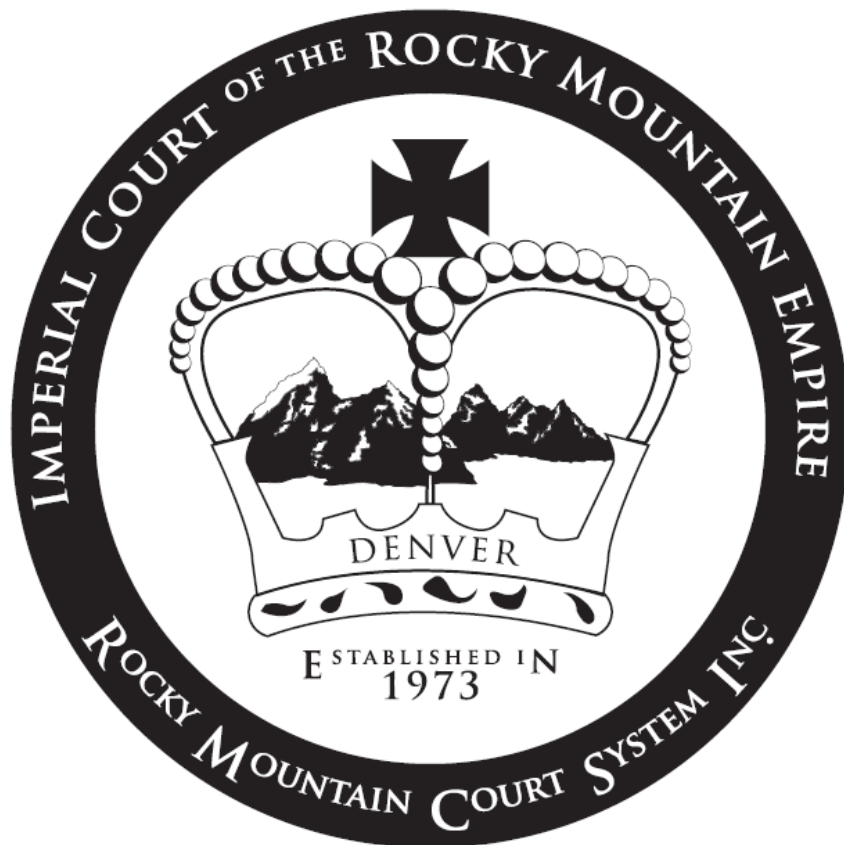
On January 1st, Emperor 42 along with Emperor 19 John Menchaca, Emperor and Empress 29 Robert Flores and Jazmine James went to celebrate Houston's coronation. A fun-filled weekend ensued when Emperor and Empress 40 of the Pikes Peak Empire joined in the antics that ensued at all the strip clubs!

In February, Reign 42, along with Salt Lake City, hosted the Seattle In-Town show, raising money for Seattle's Educational scholarship. Enjoying her 40th anniversary Empress 2 Scotti Carlyle, Emperor 7 Gary Edwards, Emperor 13 Chuck Bates and Empress 40 Lushus LaReil,, Price Royale 42 Charles Rozanski joined and Rena 42 Ladycat De'Ore in the festivities. Richard and Charles missed their flight and came in late, barely making it to the

show. Lushus had another one of those only you girl moments, she hung her wig on the light blub of a mirror. We were all looking for the light switch to turn on the lights. We fond it and her wig melted like cheese on a burger!

We began to wrap up our year hosting those annual events such as Awards Banquet, Smack-A-Star, the In-Town show, the Seattle / Salt Lake show. Gabbie and Vida attended the last out of town coronation in Ft. Worth.

Our year ended with Coronation on April 26th, 2016...the opening of 2nd set the 42nd family provided a phenomenal rendition of Madonna's MTV's Vogue, 3 months of rehearsals paid off! Together Richard and I had one crazy ride as the Elected 42nd Monarchs. Even with all the difficulty we made our year something that we are both proud of!
