

Welcome by His Most Imperial Majesty

Greetings of White Light & Love to All, Welcome to Edition Three of the 49th Reign Newsletter: King Of Hearts 49

This year's theme comes from the very first time I met Nina Montaldo. I was a 22-year-old kid absolutely fascinated by the words Nina was using. He was sitting on a bed, wearing chuck taylors, rocking his feet back and forth...he took the time to spend time with me. I learned about the language my Queer Elders had to create in order to communicate with each other without persecution. I went home and dove all the way into Queer history and found the Documentary 'The Queen' from 1968. I was blown away to see Queer Elders communicating with words and phrases that Nina used with me weeks before. It made me realize how resilient and strong my Oueer Elders are to ensure our Queer community survived a world that made no safe space for us. Our Queer community is a beautiful culture of fighters. The saying "Are you a friend of Dorothy?" is a term that came from the wonderful Dorothy Parker, an eccentric and witty writer, socialite, and political activist from the early part of the 20th century. Married to an openly bisexual man who called himself "queer as a billy goat," the pair wrote and entertained in New York and Hollywood until Parker was blacklisted as a Communist during the McCarthy era for her Civil Rights push. She welcomed many queer people into her

circles, and on her death, left her estate to Martin Luter King Ir. A true Legend. The most likely candidate for whom the term originates from, though, is none other than Dorothy Gale. Upon first publication, the Oz books were a sensation of their own inspiring musicals, plays, and movies even before the 1939 MGM epic "The Wizard of Oz". They were a blockbuster sensation before blockbusters were a thing! And they were really queer. The books are full of strong woman in close relationships with each other, gender bending princes, and more. In 1906's Road to Oz, Polychrome (literally the Rainbow's daughter, although that's pure coincidence as the LGBT rainbow flag as we know it was debuted in the '70s) tells Dorothy "You have some queer friends, Dorothy." And our plucky young heroine replies, "The queerness doesn't matter, so long as they're friends!". Queer people have always found a way to live our authentic lives. We as a people consistently take the baton and pass it onto the next generation. Unfortunately, as we see in our current climate, the fight is far from over. Actual legislation attacking our Queer community all over the USA will continue to happen unless we rise up. It is in our blood as Queer people to fight for our right to exist. We cannot do it alone, we need each other. We need to make sure there is a safe yellow brick road for the next generation to follow. It is up to us all.


